General information & Terms of Agreement: Magical Mystery Literary History Tour September 9-18, 2016

Payment and Cancellation Policy:

Payment for the land portion of the tour is payable online with Pay Pal on our registration page, or by check made out to the Kafka Project, sent to PO Box 16750, San Diego, CA 92176. Payments can also be accepted on the Square, with your credit card information. A non-refundable deposit of \$350 with completed registration form will confirm your place on the Kafka Project's Magical Mystery Literary History tour (airline tickets are not included). Here is the payment schedule:

All Early Bird Discounts expire on September 9, 2015. If you make your reservation after the final payment due date, payment in full will be required upon reservation. Should you have to cancel before August 1, 2016, 50% of payments are refundable. Cancellations after August 1, 2016 are non-refundable. All cancellations must be in writing to the Kafka Project. If for any reason, Kafka Project cancels this tour, you will receive a full refund of all payments made to the Kafka Project.

International airfare, taxes, airport fees, etc., are not included in the cost of the trip. However, airline reservations and travel insurance can be arranged through the Kafka Project's partner travel agent, [Harriet Niss at Regency Travel](#), or you are welcome to make your own arrangements. If making (your own) personal reservations, please make your reservations arriving no later than the day of the group arrival in Prague, September 9, 2016. You will be sent helpful information on what to pack and more details about our journey in the weeks prior to departure, but if you have any questions along the way to contact Kathi Diamant at kdiamant@mail.sdsu.edu.

IMPORTANT NOTE: A valid passport is required. The expiration date of your passport should be valid for at least six months after your date of departure.

Since international and domestic air schedules are subject to change at any time, we recommend that if you make your own airline reservations you do not purchase non-refundable tickets or those with high penalties for changes until we have confirmed that we have the minimum number of travelers (unless you purchase travel insurance). The Kafka Project and its agents shall have no liability for any loss resulting from cancellation or changes in international gateways, travel dates or airline schedules arranged by the individual.

Health and Medical Issues:

We welcome all travelers on this special journey, and special arrangements can be made for those with difficulty walking long distances. For able travelers, there will be a significant amount of walking, sometimes uphill or on uneven surfaces and climbing of steps. You must be able to get on and off trains, and motor coaches with minimal help necessary. If you need special assistance, we require you have someone to accompany you. We shall make every effort to allow everyone to participate in all elements of the journey, but the Kafka Project nor its agents or suppliers accept responsibility for any unused portion of the trip. Travel Insurance is always strongly recommended.

Pre-departure Information:

After reserving your space on our Magical Mystery Literary History Tour to Prague, Krakow and Berlin, you will receive your free copy of "Kafka's Last Love: The Mystery of Dora Diamant" to acquaint you with the places we'll be visiting. One month before our departure, you will receive a general informational sheet regarding Czech Republic, Poland and Germany and the final itinerary of our upcoming trip. Approximately two weeks prior to the trip, you will receive a final, updated document of information that we recommend you print out and carry with you.
